To orientate yourself face the map in line with the MacDonnell Ranges.</p> <p>Gates open 10-15 minutes prior to the Amphitheatre for Nature Theatre - Free Flying Bird Show.</p> <p>Entry is strictly not permitted once show starts.</p> <p>Don't forget to slip on protective clothing, slop on SPF 30+ sunscreen, slap on a broad-brimmed hat, seek shade, slide on sunglasses, step into sturdy footwear and drink plenty of water.</p>
