BOTANICAL TOUR: TREES OF THE DESERT



The Desert Park has a 54 hectare predator-proof area with nearly 3km of walking tracks.

To orientate yourself face the map in line with the MacDonnell Ranges.

Gates open 15 minutes prior to the Amphitheatre for Nature Theatre - Free Flying Bird Show.

Entry strictly not permitted once show starts.

Don't forget to **slip** on protective clothing, **slop** on SPF 30+ sunscreen, **slap** on a broad-brimmed hat, **seek** shade, **slide** on sunglasses, **step** into sturdy footwear and **drink** plenty of water.
